2. That the name of the proposed fire district shall be LAKEVIEW FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT.

3. That the undersigned request the Probate Judge of Tuscaloosa County, Alabama to call an election of the qualified electors residing within the proposed district area on the following questions:

"Shall there be created for the area described in the exhibit attached hereto and shown on the map further attached hereto a district for fighting fires known as the LAKEVIEW FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT; and further that a service charge or fee in the sum of 1 % (percent) or Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25.00), whichever is lesser, of the assessed value of all real property lying and being situated in said proposed area, as shown on the Tax Assessor of Tuscaloosa County, Alabama, be levied for collection beginning 3-1-89 for asseessed values constituted for the 1988 Tax Year to be utilized for all reasonable and necessary expenses of said fire district ; and further no more than Twenty-Five dollars (\$25.00) shall be charged per property owners; and further multiple dwellings or commercial property will be

That the Probate Judge of Tuscaloosa County, Alabama cause notice to be published in the Tuscaloosa News for three (3) weeks at least once a week, on the same day of each week notifying those interested qualified electors residing within the boundaries of the proposed district of the date and location for the conducting of such election and further that such election be set on a date not less than thirty (30) days and not more than forty (40) days from the date on which the said Probate Judge enters an order in connection herewith.

5. That the Probate Judge cause said election to be conducted and that the governing body of Tuscaloosa County be required to pay for the necessary expense of advertising and conducting such election out of the general funds of the County and is otherwise provided by said Act.

6. That the undersigned be granted any such other, further or different relief to which they may be entitled for the purpose of creating the LAKEVIEW FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT in accordance with said Act and any and all other applicable laws of the State of Alabama.

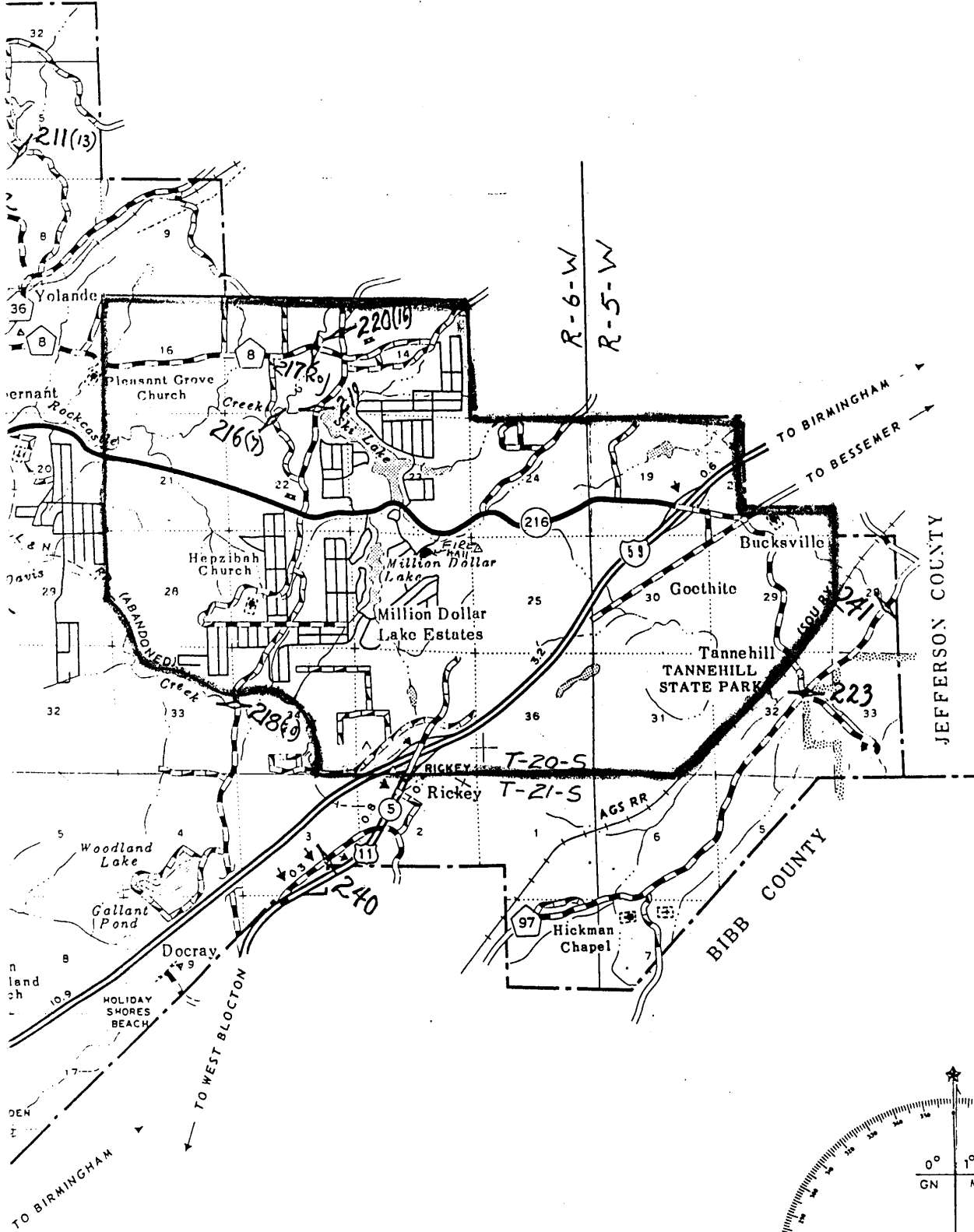

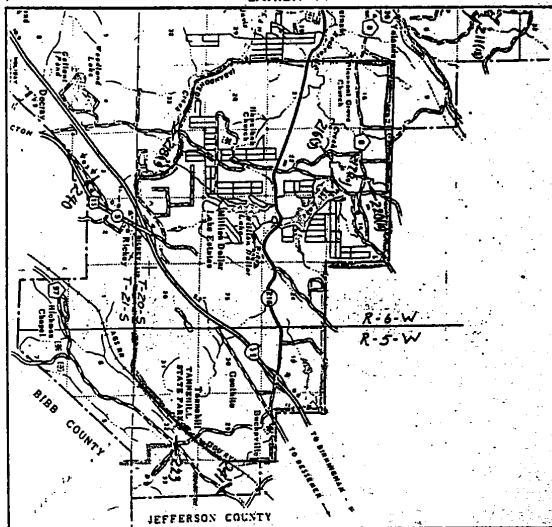
